Italdesign achieves EN 9100 certification for the aerospace sector

The certification issued by Bureau Veritas confirms that the company's processes comply with requirements recognized by the aerospace industry and strengthens Italdesign's positioning in the aerospace sector.

Moncalieri (Turin), September 4, 2026 - Italdesign has achieved EN 9100:2018 certification, the international standard defining quality management system requirements for organizations operating in the aviation, space, and defense sectors. The certification was issued by independent third-party certification body Bureau Veritas. It covers activities carried out at Italdesign's Moncalieri and Nichelino sites, confirming that the company's processes meet the requirements of one of the most demanding industrial sectors in terms of quality, safety, traceability, reliability, and process control.

EN 9100 builds upon ISO 9001 requirements by introducing additional provisions specifically designed for the aerospace industry. The standard defines the criteria necessary to ensure an organization's ability to consistently provide products and services that meet customer and regulatory requirements while fostering continuous process improvement.

The scope of certification covers styling, engineering, and testing services, as well as the production of models, prototypes, and components for the aerospace industry, confirming that these activities are performed according to procedures compliant with aerospace supply chain requirements. Achieving certification represents a significant milestone in Italdesign's continuous development of competencies and demonstrates the company's commitment to engaging with a rapidly growing sector.

This achievement is the result of a major company-wide effort that required investments in resources, organization, and the development of internal processes. The project involved multiple functions across the organization and the production sites at the Moncalieri headquarters and the Nichelino facility, further strengthening the company's organizational maturity.

"For Italdesign, EN 9100 certification represents much more than a formal milestone. We deliberately chose to move beyond self-referential claims and measure ourselves against an internationally recognized standard, entrusting an independent body with the assessment of our processes. We are not the ones declaring the quality of the way we work: it is a third party certifying our compliance with

*the requirements demanded by the aerospace industry. This recognition demonstrates the solidity of the path our company has undertaken, the commitment of our people, and our determination to operate according to globally shared standards. For customers, partners, and stakeholders, it provides an additional guarantee of reliability, transparency, and continuous improvement,” said **Antonio Casu, CEO of Italdesign.***

For companies operating within the aerospace supply chain, EN 9100 certification represents a shared standard that enables the adoption of recognized criteria, processes, and methods across the entire value chain. In this context, obtaining certification allows Italdesign to operate according to the same references and standards adopted by the industry's leading international players, further strengthening its industrial positioning.
